
READING GARDEN \$100,000

Nature themed design elements will encourage reading and exploration and include an interactive storytelling area.










CREATE SPACE \$50,000




Typical Create Space equipment can include:

- Large format wireless plotter printer










DEMONSTRATION KITCHEN \$30,000
