Project summary

Construction on the Avon Branch expansion project has started! The project will include renovations and a 16,000 SF addition to accommodate a reading garden, drive-up window, expanded meeting rooms, technology upgrades and a dedicated space for children and youth programming. Construction is expected to last 12 months.

The latest news

October has been an exciting month at the Avon Branch! The month started with site clearing. You may have noticed our small mountain of dirt being trucked away. Next was the exterior demolition, first the brick and then entire sections of wall on the north and south ends of the building. This is all to make room for the new additions.

What's to come in November

- Exterior demolition will continue
- Preparation for new wall foundations
- Ductbank installation for the new power transformer
- Structural steel starts fabrication

November will appear quieter than October. The project will be installing underground utilities and getting the site ready for foundations.
