

Sidewalk Superintendent | October 2021

Project summary

Construction on the Avon Branch expansion project is set to start soon. The project will include renovations and a 16,000 SF addition to accommodate a reading garden, drive-up window, expanded meeting rooms, technology upgrades and a dedicated space for children and youth programming. Construction is expected to last 12 months.

The latest news

In September you may have started to see changes at the Avon Branch. The landscape was cleared to make way for the new addition, a new power pole was installed along Colorado and temporary walls began on the interior. Crews have been busy making adjustments to the electrical and mechanical systems to keep the branch up and running while construction is in progress.

What's to come in October

- Removal of foundations from a building that used to be located on the property
- Installation of an entrance along Colorado for construction vehicles
- · Installation of the new transformer vault
- Delivery of underground storm structures

On the exterior of the building, crews will be preparing to install a new storm water system under the parking lot and will be getting areas next to the existing building ready for new foundations. On the interior, crews will be removing finishes from the 'construction area' to make way for the new walls to come.
