Project summary

Construction on the Avon Branch expansion project is set to start soon. The project will include renovations and a 16,000 SF addition to accommodate a reading garden, drive-up window, expanded meeting rooms, technology upgrades and a dedicated space for children and youth programming. Construction is expected to last 12 months.

The latest news

August was a busy month for the Avon Library Expansion project with a successful groundbreaking at the beginning of the month. The team also completed a site survey and drone flight to document the existing conditions before the start of construction.

What's to come in September

- Site preparation
- Fence installation
- New power pole installation
- Excavation for new additions

You'll see big changes at the library after Labor Day. First, a crew will clear the areas around the building to make room for the new additions. While it is hard to see the beautiful landscaping around the library removed, next year you'll see new plantings going in. After clearing, the project fence will be installed around the project perimeter and temporary walls will be installed on the interior of the library. The fence and walls will provide a separation between the public and construction areas. As conditions change, updates will be posted on the website.
